

## Frances Tan Si Min Musical Journey



Frances Tan Si Min is a 24 year-old Singaporean singer-songwriter and Winner of the UK Songwriting Contest 2024's Singer-songwriter Category. Growing up, Frances received many scholarship awards from the Tan Clan Association and would attend events with her late grandfather, PBM Tan Boon Kee who was a long-serving committee member of the association.

She recalls many fond memories made with her grandfather at Tan Clan over the years - "My grandfather raised me for a lot of my childhood and always emphasised the importance of doing well in school. He would always encourage me and my sister to study hard and try our best to get a scholarship award from Tan Clan every year. The scholarship award was a great encouragement to me and my sister and we had a lot of fun knowing there would be something to look forward to if we did well in school."

Frances' grandfather, PBM Tan Boon Kee, passed away in 2022, three months after she

graduated from her Undergraduate degree in Law at the London School of Economics and Political Science. "My grandpa got diagnosed with pancreatic cancer in 2021 while I was still in Law school. The doctors told him he only had 3 months left to live and it really shook me and my family as I have always been quite close to him growing up. Thankfully, he lasted 11 months longer than the doctors predicted and was able to witness my proud graduation moment virtually."

Frances recounts that her Grandpa always encouraged her to pursue a professional degree. In her Junior College days at Anglo-Chinese School (Independent), she developed an



interest in Law through a philosophical subject as part of the International Baccalaureate programme called, 'Theory of Knowledge'. "I realised through TOK that I enjoy writing argumentative essays and get a great sense of satisfaction when I am able to use my words to bring across a point in a concise and impactful way."

Her passion in writing and the strategic usage of words to express herself also explains her interest in songwriting that developed from a young age. Enamoured by her favourite artist, Taylor Swift's ability to weave characters and immersive worlds together through lyrics and melodies, Frances googled "how to write a song" when she was 13 and has been writing songs ever since then.

"For the longest time, songwriting was my best kept secret that I told no one about. Whenever I was stressed out with school, I would pick up my guitar and write a song about it." Frances' debut album (set to be released this November) will include songs

written over the past 2 to 3 years of her life, capturing the internal thoughts she had when she made the decision to pursue songwriting after Law school.



Frances just graduated from her Masters degree in Songwriting from New York University, Steinhardt where she studied under Emmy and Grammy-winning professors who have written songs recorded by the likes of Whitney Houston, Celine Dion, Beyonce, Ariana Grande, Cher and more.

This year, in celebration of SG60 and in commemoration of the 10th anniversary of the passing of the late Mr Lee Kuan Yew, Frances wrote and produced a song and music video titled 'Ride into the Sun' to give thanks to Singapore's founding Fathers for all that we have today. Frances flew from New York to

Singapore to perform the song for the first time on 22 March 2025 at SG100 Foundation's annual dinner event, Lest We Forget 2025 where she was presented the SG100 Foundation B.O.L.D. Award for being an outstanding Singaporean living her dreams. In attendance was

Former President of Singapore, Mdm Halimah Yacob and many foreign ambassadors of various countries. Frances was subsequently appointed as the Youth and Arts Ambassador of SG100 Foundation after this event.

"I hope my song and lyrics will inspire Singaporeans to have a heart of gratitude towards our founding Fathers for all that we have today. In just a few short decades, they brought us from third world to first, and it is because of this strong foundation they built for us that we have the opportunity to pursue our dreams today. I hope it will also encourage Singaporeans to keep building on what we have and pass on an even better Singapore for future generations to come."

This National Day season, Frances received many invitations from Ministers, Member of Parliaments and organisations across Singapore and performed 'Ride into the Sun' live at more than 20 different SG60 National Day events. For example, the Ministry of Defence's NDP Bay Celebrations at Marina Bay, NDP Heartland

Frances also performed at the Singapore Trade Office's SG60 Reception in Taipei at Grand Hyatt Taipei and at SingaporeConnect's Singapore Festival in San Francisco, California in August and September 2025 respectively.

Frances was also part of the National Day Celebrations held in schools across Singapore. More than 14 schools around Singapore like Crescent Girls' School, Jurong Pioneer JC, Zhenghua Primary, ACS Primary and ACS Independent screened her music video on 8 August 2025 as part of their National Day Celebrations. Henry Park Primary School, her alma-mater, invited her to perform the song live and lead the mass singing segment on 6 August and 8 August 2025 as part of their National Day Celebrations.

The music video for 'Ride into the Sun' was also screened on Shaw Theatres Lido, Balestier and Jewel's indoor and outdoor screens from 19 July to 17 August 2025 in celebration of SG60, and on Our Tampines Hub's screens for the whole month of August.

'Ride into the Sun' was written and composed Frances Tan Si Min, a 24 year old Singaporean singer-songwriter based in New York City (she is also SG100 Foundation's Youth Ambassador). She wrote the song inline with the theme of the dinner 'Lest We Forget', to remind us to understand the past and appreciate the present so we can be ready for the future. Frances flew back from New York City to record the music video that was used as the backdrop of her performance, and to sing the song personally with her band. Frances is currently completing her Masters degree in Songwriting at New York University, after completing her Undergraduate degree in Law at the London School of Economics and Political Science.
